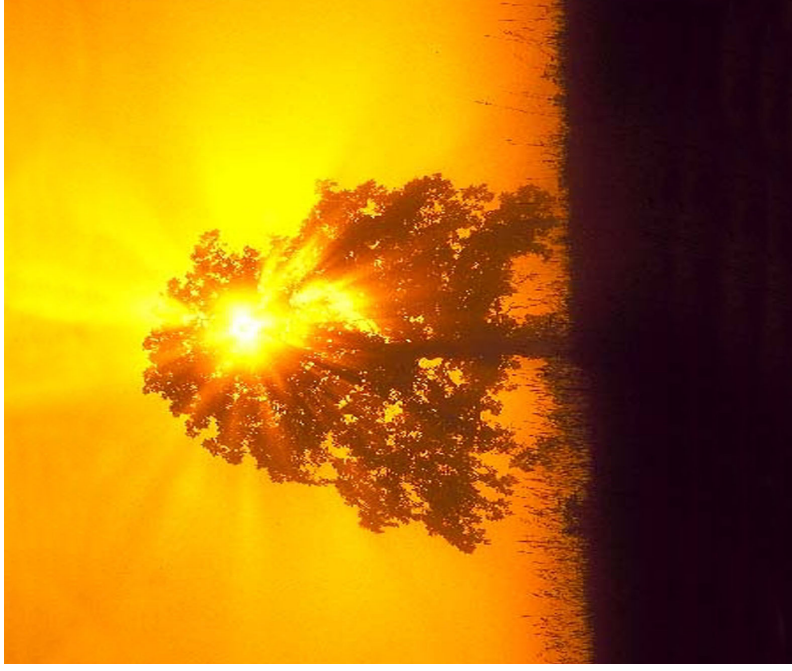

Your money can be endowed in a number of ways:

- You can designate a particular organization you want to support.
- It can be endowed to address a field of interest, such as health, children's issues, scholarships or economic development, as an example.
- It can be permanently endowed, which means only 5% can be spent out of the fund each year.
- Money can be invested in various amounts, and when that fund reaches \$10,000, then it can be endowed.

You will receive an additional **20% State tax credit**, over Federal & State charitable deductions. (On a first come first served basis)

What happens to the money you bequeath?

A total of 5% of the funds will be returned to Clayton County Foundation For The Future to invest in the county and community by awarding grants to non-profit and charitable organizations that build on community assets and respond to community needs. Only 5% is spent each year, to ensure that the funds exist into perpetuity.

CFGD will oversee the administrative paperwork and investment returns and reporting for the Clayton County Foundation For The Future. Adding CCF's money to the fund already established by CFGD allows us to earn a much higher return on all investments, since a much larger amount of money will be invested by joining forces. Also the cost to administer the fund will be greatly reduced as CFGD's administration is already in place. This leaves your endowment properly managed to make the best possible return of investment for the least possible cost, giving your dollars the legacy you deserve for your communities continued strength, growth, and prosperity.
